On-Campus Housing

On-campus student apartments in Eagle Heights may be rented by students with spouses, domestic partners, children, or other legal dependents. The monthly rates for 2019–2020 rentals at Eagle Heights were \$898 for one-bedroom units, \$995–\$1,134 for two-bedroom units, and \$1,168–\$1,300 for three-bedroom units. Three-bedroom townhouse units are also available for \$1,340 per month. Single graduate students may request housing in the Harvey Street Apartments for \$850–\$1,042 per month.
